

## GOING BACKWARDS TO GO FORWARDS FOR CANCER CARE

## 15 August 2022

Patrick Kelly will attempt a world record in driving a tractor and trailer, in reverse, during the National Ploughing Championships. He will attempt this challenge in a 1962 Massey Ferguson tractor with no power steering.

The National Ploughing Championships will take place in Ratheniska, Co. Laois from September 20th to 22<sup>nd.</sup> This Guinness world record attempt will take place on <u>Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> September</u>.

This extraordinary fundraising effort – to raise over €150,000 - by Patrick is in honour of his mother, Mai Kelly, who died of cancer. All proceeds will be used to support **cancer care** in St James's Hospital.
