Martin Kehoe (Wexford) represented Ireland with distinction, finishing 8th overall in a highly competitive field. Congratulations to both competitors on their remarkable achievements!

Ireland will be represented in the 2026 World Ploughing Contest in Croatia, 5th & 6th Sept., by John Whelan (Wexford) and Eamonn Tracey (Carlow). Gary Simms will be coach, with Harry Mallon as judge. Best of luck to the team as they prepare for the competition!



2025 European Ploughing Championships

The Rep. of Ireland team performed brilliantly at the European Ploughing Contest. John Whelan (Wexford) set the pace on Day 1, earning first place and later securing the title of Overall Reserve Champion. Dan Donnelly (Wexford) excelled on Day 2, taking the top spot and ultimately being named the Overall Champion. Well done to both competitors on these outstanding accomplishments!
